INSTRUCTIONS:

MAKE SURE YOU DO A SEARCH BY DEBTOR BY "BUSINESS NAME" FOR "JOHN HENRY DOE TRUST", and if that doesn't come up try LAST NAME, and other variations, try searching by Secured Party, etc. Try "DOE TRUST" in last name. The forms are usually CASE SENSITIVE.

When it shows up in a search, most UCC offices will have the names of the SECURED PARTY "John-Henry: Doe" come up in ALL CAPITALS LIKE "DOE; JOHN-HENRY" however this is just STYLING as their computer only allows for entries in ALL CAPS in the SEARCH database. Rest assured that the ucc form you sent it was not altered in any way. When you click "View" you should be able to see your filing and check that everything is all there and visible. You will see that they may have redacted any/all unique identifying numbers like BC number/SSN/etc.

Secured Party Name may be in ALL CAPS, this is OK! This is just styling. On the recording they recorded the actual forms exactly how you submitted them, with the secured party name in Upper- and Lower: case letters.

Click to View the UCC recording and check it's all there and proper

The "View" may not be available right away, it could take a longer period of time for the entire recording to become visible.

If it doesn't show up in a search after you've done your diligence, the next step is to call the UCC Division with the Certified/Express Mail Number that you mailed it and give them the date it arrived (look up on USPS.com the date it was delivered to them), and ask them if it was recorded. (They can and will give you the Filing Number on the phone). Then you can look it up via filing number online easier by typing in the Filing Number in the search under "SEARCH BY FILING NUMBER" instead of SEARCH BY DEBTOR, or SEARCH BY SECURED PARTY NAME.
